



PHOTO COMPETITION BRITAIN AS I REMEMBER IT

After the spectacular Royal Wedding, the capital of Great Britain will again be in the limelight during the summer of 2012, this time as the host of the 30th Summer Olympic and Paralympic Games. This is the third time that London, after the Games in 1908 and 1948, will host this largest global sports event.

Towards 2012 London Olympics, the British Embassy in Serbia launched a photo competition "Britain as I remember it", on December 08, 2011. Citizens of Serbia who have visited the UK and there captured a moment spent in a sports environment, on a playground, at a stadium, a tennis court, in a gym, etc., are invited to submit their photos and seize the opportunity to win a trip to London! Along with the photo, it is necessary to submit a description which will specify the location where the photo was taken, as well as a personal comment or some interesting facts related to it. Apart from the trip to London for two, which will be the "gold medal" of this competition, the Embassy will award the authors of the second and the third-ranked winning photos.

Finalists of the contest will be chosen by the visitors of the "Britain as I remember it" Facebook page launched for the contest, while the first three places will be elected by the judging panel, consisted of prominent sports photographers, athletes and journalists. Winners will be announced on February 11, 2012 at the ceremony organized in the residence of the British Ambassador to Serbia, Michael Davenport, during the "UK in Serbia Week". The best works will be presented at the exhibition scheduled for April 18, which will coincide with 100 days left until the beginning of the 2012 Olympics.
